

General procedure and requirements at Lincoln Center

Dress Code: Performers are expected to wear formal stage attire (dresses for ladies and pants/suits for gentlemen).

Concert Etiquette: Audience members should refrain from any acts of special attention to performers during the recital, e.g. handing of flowers and/or gifts to performers on stage.

Video Recording/Photo Policy: Use of recording equipment (photo and video cameras) during the recital is strictly prohibited. This is a Concert Hall requirement. In case of a licensed professional photographer will be making archival pictures of performers, please visit our Facebook page https://www.facebook.com/Golden.Key.Music.Festivals photo gallery at approximately in two weeks after the recital and download your pictures.

- Welcome Cards will be available for pickup 30 minutes prior to the recital at the Hall's door.
 For the Standard Recital Fee you should find four Welcome Cards in the envelope. The envelope contains the Performer's ID Card as well.
- Both performers and guests will enter through the Main Entrance of the Concert Hall.
- Performers should register at least 10 minutes prior to curtain time.
- Performers will be seated in the first and seconds rows of the Orchestra.
- Guests are welcome to occupy any seats behind the second row on a first-come, first-served basis.
